President's Message



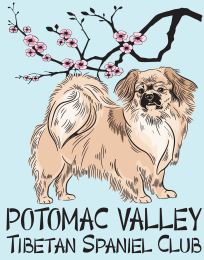
August 29, 2023

Breeder Referral: two submission forms received, one for show and one for companion.

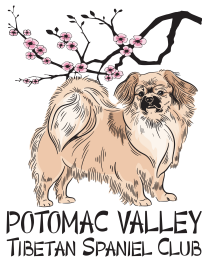
Unfinished Business: None
